PROGRAM NOTE

Three little pieces were written as a composition project to do a cycle of small pieces for solo piano with a more contemporary harmonic language.

Fleeting Storm

In this piece, I wanted to represent a fleeting storm with the use of the rhythm, dynamics and chords appearing in the middle of the phrases. The harmony also help to shape external elements that make reference to storms, like thunders.

Nocturne

A slow movement following the idea of the Nocturne Form. This piece is the most challenging in terms of Harmony.

Playing time

A playful tune that develops from a simple rhythmic and melodic pattern, the harmony changes in leaps of augmented fourths.
